Ouachita Hills Academy offers some classes (science, history, and so/jr Bible) on a rotating year basis. On years beginning with an odd number, Science of the Physical Creation, Chemistry, Anatomy & Physiology/Health, American History, and Pauline Epistles are offered. On years beginning with an even number, Biology, Physics, World History, and Daniel & Revelation are offered. These would be the typical classes (not including Vocational Classes) that students would be in.

A student must obtain 24 units and maintain a GPA of 2.0 in order to graduate. These 24 units must include the following:

For a General Course of Study:

- Bible – 1 unit for every year at a church school
- English – 4 units
- Math – 3 units (Algebra ½ does not fulfill requirement)
- Consumer Math – ½ unit (first semester required for all)
(A full year required for those who do not take Algebra 2)
- Social Studies – 2 units (United States & World)
- Computers – ½ unit
- Typing ½ unit
- Anatomy & Physiology – ½ unit
- Health – ½ unit
- Science – 2 units
- Choir – each year in attendance at OHA

Vocational Classes – 1 unit each year in attendance at OHA, it must include:

- Foods & Nutrition – ½ unit
- Agriculture – 1 unit
- Sewing (girls) – ½ unit
- Carpentry (boys) – ½ unit

Vocational Lab – 1 unit each year in attendance at OHA

For a College Preparatory Course of Study include:

- Foreign Language – 2 units
- Algebra 2
- Geometry or PreCalculus
- Science – total of 3 units
